Impact of Damage Caused by Record Snowfall on Consolidated Financial Results

On February 15, 2014, record snowfall caused partial damage to factory buildings, including the collapse of some roofing, at Furukawa Electric's Nikko Works (Nikko City, Tochigi Prefecture), which manufactures copper strip-related products. Updates were provided on February 17, 20 and 27 and on April 25 on the status of the recovery efforts. We will continue working towards a complete recovery by the end of 2014. The following information concerns the impact of the above snow damage on the Company's consolidated financial results.

The operating loss for the Fiscal Year Ended March 31, 2014 indicates combined losses from opportunity loss resulting from products that could not be shipped from Nikko Works and indirect impact. The extraordinary loss for the Fiscal Year Ended March 31, 2014 refers to recovery costs, destruction of assets, and fixed costs during periods of non-operation, etc.

The forecast for the Fiscal Year Ending March 31, 2015 has been prepared based on assumptions and judgments made by Furukawa Electric Group using information available at the time of the announcement.

The above results and forecast have been included in the accounts for the Fiscal Year Ended March 31, 2014 and the forecast for the Fiscal Year Ending March 31, 2015, announced today.
